

COORDINATION WITH NAPA COUNTY

- CONCERNS DUE TO:
 - Adjacent airport
 - Flood control
- ADDRESSED THROUGH:
 - Multiple meetings with napa county and airport representatives
 - Expert consultation
 - Additional data review
 - Mitigation measures in the EIR

AIRPORT COORDINATION

- THREE CONCERNS:
 - Bird Strikes/Aircraft Safety
 - Airport safety (conflict with recreation)
 - Flooding at end of runway
- BIRD STRIKE ISSUES
 - Airport is surrounded by bird habitat
 - Studies show tidal marsh habitat has less dangerous birds than open water
 - Mitigation
 - Reduce time to vegetation establishment
 - Specific bird monitoring for area closest to airport

FLOOD CONTROL

- POTENTIAL CONCERN DUE TO:
 - Leaking, possibly under-sized culvert
 - Low levees around airport
 - Increased upstream run-off (development)
- MITIGATION:
 - Redesign culvert
 - Increase levee height in project vicinity
 - Work with airport to address impact of Runway Safety Area over No Name Creek
 - Need to distinguish between tidal and non-tidal flooding
